## IF THE DOG IS ALREADY REGISTERED WITH THE DOG

Under Dogs New Zealand (DNZ) Regulations the vendor(s) must complete and forward to DNZ a completed transfer of this dog within 14 days of the date of sale. Upon completion of Registration formalities the DNZ will then forward to the purchaser(s) a Certificate of Ownership of the dog showing the purchaser(s) as owner of the dog. This document includes a three generation pedigree of the dog.

## IF THE DOG IS NOT ALREADY BUT IS TO BE REGISTERED WITH DOGS NEW ZEALAND

The vendor(s) should undertake to complete registration formalities with DNZ within 14 days of date of sale. (*Unless this document or the law specifically states otherwise the date of sale is the date of delivery or possession of the dog*). Upon completion of Registration formalities DNZ will then forward to the purchaser(s) a Certificate of Ownership of the dog showing the purchaser(s) as owner of the dog. This document includes a three generation pedigree of the dog.

**NOTE** only the breeder can make the initial registration of the dog. If the vendor(s) is not the breeder and the dog is not already registered with DNZ then this section cannot be included in any contract sale.

## IF THE DOG IS SOLD WITH DOGS NEW ZEALAND ENDORSEMENTS

(Restrictions on Ownership)

If the dog is to be registered with DNZ all or any of the following endorsements can be placed on the registration of the dog with the agreement of the new owner. (*Note the purchaser(s) must also sign the DNZ forms agreeing to any endorsements*).

- **1.** Not to be bred from.
- 2. Not to be shown.
- 3. Not to be bred from under 12/18/24/36 months. (*Indicate period*)
- 4. Not to be bred from unless X-rayed for HD.
- 5. Not to be bred from unless X-rayed for HD and scored a total of eight or less with not more than six on any one hip.
- 6. Monorchid.
- 7. Cryptorchid.
- 8. Not eligible for issue of Export Certificate.
- 9. Restricted Register (Endorsments 1,2 and 8 apply)
